Career Highlights

- Enters 2017 riding a streak of seven consecutive top-10 finishes
- In 2016, had wins in consecutive tournaments at the Sime Darby LPGA Malaysia and the TOTO Japan Classic and crossed the \$8 million mark in career earnings with a T8 finish at the season-ending 2016 CME Group Tour Championship
- Had two wins on the Ladies European Tour (LET) in 2016 including her fourth Omega Dubai Ladies Masters title
- In 2015, had two wins on the LET and became the first Chinese player to win the Tour's Order of Merit
- Captured two wins in 2013 including the Reignwood LPGA Classic in her home country and the CME Group Titleholders
- In 2012, became a Rolex First-Time Winner and the first-ever Chinese winner on Tour at the Wegmans LPGA Championship
- Shot a career-low 63 on two occasions, both in the final rounds of the 2008 LPGA State Farm Classic and the 2014 Sime Darby Malaysia
- As an amateur, finished tied for ninth at the 2007 LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn LPGA status and to become the first player from China to earn Tour status
